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2010 City of New Haven, Connecticut Declaration of Personal Property (Motor Vehicles)

1. Per the CT DMV, "Once you have established residency in Connecticut, you have 60 days to transfer your vehicle(s) registration to this state."
2. Should you choose to maintain an out of state registration, you have 90 days to register with the City Assessor, upon which you shall present a copy of your most current registration for assessment purposes.
3. If moving from one Connecticut town to another, you must notify the DMV and register the vehicle to the correct address within 48 hours of the address change.

Filing Requirement – This declaration **must be filed by November 1st** with the Assessor of the town where the personal property is located. Declarations of personal property shall be made annually.

You must return this declaration to the Assessor and provide information related to the name of the new owner of the property or the date your personal property was moved outside of the New Haven jurisdiction. Otherwise, the Assessor must assume that you are still are in possession of such personal property and have failed to declare your taxable personal property.

Penalty for late filing – Failure to file timely will result in a penalty equal to 25% of the assessment of the personal property. This declaration must be filed or postmarked no later than:
