Elm City Resident Card 5th Anniversary

To apply for the Elm City Resident Card, you will need:

ONE of the following "Category A" IDs:

- Passport
- U.S. Driver's License
- Birth Certificate (for kids 16 and under only)
- Consular ID Card

- At least one Category A or Category B ID must have a photo.
- For full list of acceptable documents, please visit the application form website.

-OR-

TWO of the following "Category B" IDs:

- National identification card (must have photo, name, address, date of birth and expiration date);
- Foreign Driver's license (current - NOT expired);
- Voter registration card (must be presented with original birth certificate)
- U.S. or Foreign military identification card (must be presented with original birth certificate)
- Visa (current)
- ITIN card (must be accompanied by an ID with a photograph)

AND TWO proofs of residency (i.e. utility bill, insurance card, etc.)
