Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP) Eligibility Screening Information



United Way’s 2-1-1 will provide eligibility screening and referral to all of CT HPRP’s programs. The trained Homeless/Housing Plus specialists at 2-1-1 will screen for potential eligibility and connect eligible callers directly to the HPRP program in their area. For callers who are not eligible for HPRP services, based upon the pre-screen tool, referrals will be made to other appropriate services and agencies.

To qualify, applicants must meet the following thresholds:

- Income must be at or below 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI). For New Haven, 80% of the AMI (Low Income) for FY 2009 are as follows:

1	\$44,800.00
2	\$51,200.00
3	\$57,600.00
4	\$64,000.00
5	\$69,100.00
6	\$74,250.00
7	\$79,350.00
8	\$84,500.00

- Must be homeless or would be homeless *but for* this assistance.

The Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) Pre Screening tool also collects the following information:

- Total annual household income
- Household composition
- Have appropriate subsequent housing options been identified?
- Does the household lack the financial resources and support networks needed to obtain immediate housing or remain in existing housing?

Persons interested in HPRP assistance must call 2-1-1 for prescreening and referral to appropriate agency.
