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The New Haven Solid Waste and Recycling Authority (“Authority”) hereby serves notice that it has issued this Addendum No. 2 to the Request for Qualifications (“RFQ”) for Transfer Station Operation, Transport and Disposal Services for Municipal Solid Waste, issued September 8, 2011. **SECTION 1.0: CLARIFICATIONS AND RESPONSE TO WRITTEN QUESTIONS**

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Comments were received in writing during the SOQ preparation period. This section is intended to address the written questions submitted subsequent to issuance of Addendum No. 1 on September 13, 2011 and as of September 19, 2011.

- 1. What is the current all in rate being paid to the current vendor? Specifically what are the maintenance, loading, hauling and disposal costs of approximately 75,000 tons annually?**

The Authority presently pays the current contract operator \$75.40 per ton for the loading, haul and disposal of municipal solid waste delivered to the Transfer Station. The Authority currently pays an additional \$597,923 annually for operations and maintenance of the Transfer Station. Therefore, the total current annual payment to the contract operator for the operation and management of the Transfer Station and

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the loading, haul and disposal of 75,000 tons of municipal solid waste would be approximately \$6.253 million.

**2. Can you provide the names and contact information for the specification holders of the above Request for Qualifications?**

The Authority cannot provide the names and contact information of firms who may have received copies of the RFQ as an accurate list is not readily available. All information related to the RFQ is posted electronically and the City of New Haven and the Authority have not maintained records of the entities that may have downloaded them. The Authority upon request, however, will provide a list of the Respondents to the RFQ once the SOQs are received on September 22, 2011.
