ADVISORY

New Residential Parking Zone #6

Please be advised, that George Street, Greenwood Street and Gilbert Avenue, are now designated as residential parking zones (Zone #6). Both sides of George Street from Winthrop Avenue to Sherman Avenue, both sides of Greenwood Street from Scranton Street to George Street, and both sides of Gilbert Avenue from Winthrop Avenue to Waverly Street will be posted and enforced.

In areas posted as RESIDENTIAL PARKING ZONES, parking will be available only to persons meeting the residency requirements (and their guests), as specified in the ordinances, and who display a valid RESIDENTIAL ZONE 6 sticker on their vehicle(s).

In the near future, the zone will be posted with street signs. Permit holders are still subject to all other posted regulations in their zone, including no parking for street sweeping or snow emergency when applicable. The fine for parking in a residential parking district without a permit is \$20; this fine doubles in 15 days if not paid, and triples after 30 days.

You can purchase a Residential Parking Decal at the Office of the Tax Collector, 165 Church Street, New Haven during normal business hours.
