This is to certify that, **Emily Dow and Christopher Corbett**, owners of the property located at **14 Hallock Avenue**, a building located in the **City Point Local Historic District** is found to comply substantially with the requirements of the Historic District Ordinances of the City of New Haven in regard to:

Installation of fences as described in testimony before the Commission and as described as follows: The front fence is to be 36" high. It shall be affixed to 4x4" posts approximately eight feet on center. The 1x3" pickets shall be approximately 5" on center. The pickets shall have chamfered tops. The bottom rail is composed of a 1x3" front rail and a 2x3" back rail. The rear privacy fence is approved as noted in the application as consisting of 6x8 foot wood panels with 5/8"x 4". wood pickets (Millstead Gothic Whitewood, HOME DEPOT store SKU #123351 or equivalent). Approval is with the condition that the fence lines conform to the existing driveway alignment and relevant property rights.
